

Baltimore Delegation Fact Sheet

WHAT IS JCC MACCABI

JCC Maccabi is the world's largest gathering of Jewish teenagers with nearly 5,000 teens participating from across the world. It is a week-long sports endeavor for Jewish teens ages 13-17, featuring round-robin and medal-round competitions, Opening and closing ceremonies, inhome and/or dormitory hospitality, community services and social activities that strengthen bonds to Jewish heritage, community and Israel.

DATES & LOCATION:

Tucson, AZ, July 27 – August 1 2025 JCC Maccabi Games & Access Pittsburgh, PA, August 3 – August 8, 2025 JCC Maccabi Campus Games

The delegation travels together for the trip and historically departs Baltimore Sunday Morning and returns before Shabbat on Friday. It is required for each participant to be present during the entire trip. All athletes and coaches are expected to travel with the delegation (transportation is arranged by the JCC).

Eligibility:

Must be between the ages of 13 on July 27, 2025 and 17 on August 8, 2025

All Athletes must be Jewish – defined as follows:

One of the athletes parents is Jewish and the athlete is being raised Jewish or is a Jew by choice and is being raised Jewish. In the spirit of JCC Maccabi if the parent or child does not believe that they are Jewish on a year around basis, then the child should not participate in JCC Maccabi programs. In the athlete registration, there is a declaration that contains the eligibility requirements; both the athlete and his/her parent(s) must sign this declaration.

TEAM EXPECTATIONS:

For team sports, we strive to send full teams. If we do not have enough interest locally to field a full team, we will send athletes to compete as part of a mixed team, where delegations are randomly assigned to play together and meet at JCC Maccabi. Coaches will share team expectations regarding practices etc. once teams are formed.

All JCC Maccabi teens are expected to attend as many JCC Maccabi related sponsored events held this year. More details to come

MEDICAL FORMS:

Each participant must have a JCC Maccabi specific medical form filled out to participate. The medical form is due online by Sunday, June 1, 2025. For any medical form not submitted by Sunday, June 1, 2025, a **\$150 late fee** will be assessed to your account.

REGISTRATION:

Once teams are finalized, all participants will be required to put down a nonrefundable \$500 deposit within 5 days of making the team to secure your spot. We will hold a virtual registration/info night on February 27, 7-8:30pm to explain the registration process and calendar requirements for the year.
